

SETUP OF AUTORUN FOR MULTIPLE USERS

BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

Complete the setup of your Autorun user interface. Save your Autorun interface with a name you will remember. The entire "operator-proofing" of your Autorun interface will be completed in 3 steps: <u>Setup of New Users</u>, <u>Setting User Privileges</u>, and <u>Configuring Autorun to Boot Automatically at Login</u>.

Note: This procedure will work for all versions 4.2 and older – some steps below are not needed in 4.2, but are necessary in older versions of Calypso.

SETUP OF NEW USERS:

From the Autorun user interface (LOGGED IN AS MASTER):

1) Choose CONFIGURATION>USER>CHANGE USER

- > Type the name of the new user in the dropdown menu provided
- Press ENTER key on keyboard
- > Click ADD Button in System Setup window
- OK out of the System Setup window

2) Choose CONFIGURATION>USER>CHANGE USER



- Click the TAB at the bottom of the window for the newly user
- Click SWITCH TO button

- > OK all messages that pop up as you log in the first time as this user.
- > OK out of the System Setup window.

3) Choose CONFIGURATION>USER>CHANGE USER

- > Click the TAB at the bottom of the window for the Master
- Click the SWITCH TO button
- > Log in as the Master
- > OK out of the System Setup Window



SETTING USER PRIVLEDGES:

From Autorun user interface (LOGGED IN AS MASTER):

1) Choose CONFIGURATION>USER>PRIVLEDGES

- Click Checkbox "ON" for whatever privileges you want the user to have. NOTE: You MUST allow START/STOP Measurement
- OK out of the User Rights Window
- 2) Choose CONFIGURATION>USER>CHANGE USER
 - > Click the TAB at the bottom of the window for the New User
 - Click the SWITCH TO button
 - Log in as the New User
 - OK out of the System Setup Window
- 3) To test, try to add new icons, close Autorun, move icons, change measurement parameters, etc. to show that the user privileges work to your satisfaction.





CONFIGURING AUTORUN TO BOOT AUTOMATICALLY AT LOGIN:

From a BLANK Calypso Workdesk (LOGGED IN AS MASTER):

1) Choose EXTRAS>WORKROOM>USER



- > Click the TAB at the bottom of the window for the New User
- Click the SWITCH TO button
- Log in as the New User
- OK out of the System Setup window
- 2) Choose EXTRAS>WORKROOM>ENVIRONMENT
 - Click START WITH AUTORUN
 - Click OPEN AN AUTORUN FILE
 - Click OPEN PLAN NAMED BELOW
 - > Click the BROWSE button and choose the filename of your Autorun *.arn file
 - OK out of the System Setup window



3) Exit Calypso completely and log in as the new user – Calypso will always start automatically with the selected Autorun user interface when the new user logs in.
